Pilot Project Phase I

- ▶ FSSA grant to develop DSP training program to retain and up-skill currently employed DSPs
- ▶ Ivy Tech Community College has curriculum helpful to DSPs
- ▶ Campuses in most sizeable communities throughout Indiana
- ▶ Provide college credit to award Technical Certificate in Human Services
- ▶ Two training cohorts of 10 students each—no cost to DSPs or agencies
- ▶ One course per 8-week session
- ▶ Students in closed-cohort courses
- ▶ Phase I concentrated in Northwest Indiana

Structure & Delivery of Curriculum

- ▶ Courses of first cohort Monday & Wednesday evenings, 6-8:45pm
- ▶ “Learn Anywhere” delivery method
- ▶ One course per 8-week session
- ▶ Two years to complete 31 credit Technical Certificate in Human Services
- ▶ Curriculum pre-determined with no electives
- ▶ Currently finishing year one of first cohort
- ▶ Beginning recruitment for second cohort (Tuesdays & Thursdays, 6-8:45pm)

Curriculum

First Year

- ▶ Term 1: IVYT 111 & HUMS 101: Introduction to Human Services
- ▶ Term 2: HUMS 102: Helping Relationship Techniques
- ▶ Term 3: HUMS 103: Interviewing & Assessment
- ▶ Term 4: PSYC 101: Introduction to Psychology
- ▶ Term 5: COMM 102: Interpersonal Communication

Curriculum

Second Year

- ▶ Term 1: HUMS 116: Introduction to Disabilities
- ▶ Term 2: HUMS 104: Crisis Intervention
- ▶ Term 3: HUMS 205: Theories of Behavior Modification
- ▶ Term 4: HUMS 140: Loss and Grief
- ▶ Term 5: HUMS 220: Issues & Ethics in Human Services

Conclusion & Evaluation

- ▶ Upon successful conclusion, students will be awarded 31 credit-hour Technical Certificate in Human Services
- ▶ Pre-Test and Post-Test
- ▶ Subjective student evaluations (each course & entire program)
- ▶ Feedback from agency supervisors
- ▶ Desired outcome: retention of DSPs, increase in quality of services delivered, increased job satisfaction, greater likelihood of salary increases and promotion
- ▶ Credits from Technical Certificate may be applied toward completion of an Associate of Applied Science degree at student's expense.
- ▶ Eventual offering of DSP Technical Certificate from all Ivy Tech campuses




