



Structured Family Caregiving	
Pros	Cons
Generally, SFC providers have a 5+ tenure with individuals where DSPs generally average about 12 months with a consumer.	Because housing and direct care staffing are connected, if a person loses their SFC provider, they also lose their housing
The individual supported generally experiences a family relationship with the SFC provider, participating in family gatherings, holidays, etc.	The SFC Caregiver may have more control and influence over the individual since there are not multiple staff interacting with the consumer daily and weekly, so less likely ANE would be reported by another staff
SFC usually comes with housing, and its housing they care about and keep up with because they live in that house.	
The SFC Caregiver works from home, which may increase stability of the arrangement	
Most SFC provide transportation to support a person's needs
